

Hello South West Idaho Club officers.

1. For new officers, I need their Names, position, phone numbers and e-mail addresses. These will be listed on the paper calendar and the web site pages.
2. Meeting times and locations of regular club meetings (open to public)
3. Names of the central person to contact for the events and their phone number, if not the club officer. Usually, I like to put the road captains number on the event. But I can put a special number if necessary.
4. Dates of major, open to the public events with locations and times.
5. Check your current listing, by club on the web sites

Make any changes and forward me an e-mail from the page (small letter ICON)

The plan again is to complete and publish the paper calendar by March 1, and the web site updated by March 15. Final review copies to be e-mailed two weeks prior to those dates.

The data file for the calendar will be given to each club to print and distribute as they choose. 100 calendar sheets will be given to the motorcycle shops listed on the calendar listing by March 15 or soon there after. The paper calendar only runs from May through October. Pre and post season dates are listed as space is available.

Cost this year will be \$20 per club, payable to me, to cover cost of printing and distribution of the paper calendars and for the web site hosting fees. At least 1200 copies were printed last year and distributed to MC shops in the valley. This nominal fee is requested to get your events published in the paper and web site editions. Last year several new clubs came forward asking to be included after it was too late.

The web site hosting costs are \$100/year. The additional money collected this year from each club is to pay for the site hosting. Any extra money will be donated to a local charity.

I occasionally get requests for a club or event to be added to the SWIMCC calendar, so I have included my policy (for lack of a better one) that I have been using for the last four years.

Any club or event can be published under the following guidelines:

1. Any club must be a "public" club, i.e. no special requirements for membership. The only exceptions to that rule are clubs that are "brand" centric, like HOG, GWRRA, and BMW.
2. Any event has to be a "public" event with no restrictions of any kind. No exceptions. Special large events, like Sturgis, are included more for planning purposes because of the large interest. Some individuals sponsor events that I include like the "Chili burger run" and the "Halloween Ride" and are annual events.
3. Local charity events are listed as a public service and must be locally sponsored by clubs or individuals. Like Ride to Read, or Hope House ride
4. Any web sites listed must not contain offensive material.
5. Space is very limited on the paper calendar and events are listed on a "space available" basis.
6. Once the paper calendar is printed (frozen) any new dates will only be published on the SWIMCC web site. Because of the cost of printing the SWIMCC is printed only once. However, you can always download a .PDF version of the latest version from the SWIMCC web site.
